




## Auster A.O.P Mk.III

## **History** in brief

The Taylorcraft Auster Air Observation Post (AOP) was a British military liaison and observation aircraft produced by the Taylorcraft Aeroplanes (England) Limited company. These aircraft originated from the American Taylorcraft sport plane of 1938, which was built in England under licence with the Blackburn Cirrus Minor I engine (model C). The Auster Mk III version (model E) was a re-engined aircraft with which was the same as the Auster I but had a 130 hp (97 kW) de Havilland Gipsy Major engine. The 470 Auster Mk IIIs were bulit.
