


## **D.510J Japan service**

In 1930, aircraft designer E. Dewoitine developed the D.500 fighter design. In november 1933, his company, Construction Aeronautiques Emile Dewoitine, was given a contract for 60 examples. The first production aircraft took flight on 29.11.1934, and in july 1935 D.501 aircraft entered service wich the french AF, followed by the D.510 variant in october 1936.

Dewoitine D.500 was an all-metal, open-cockpit, fixed-undercarriage monoplane fighter aircraft, in total, an estimated 381 aircraft were built.
