An-14 - all-metal piston two engines strut-framed high plane with twin-fill tail, fixed landing upon, and tail cargo-and-passenger door. This short takeoff and landing aircraft can be used on unequipped and unpaved airfields. Batch production began in 1966. There were built 340 airpianes.

The model is executed on technology short run and is intended only for experienced modelers
