







De Havilland DH-60 became an ancestor of the whole Moth airplanes family. which made a revolution in aircraft building of Great Britain. DH-60 prototype made its maiden flight in February 1925. The final version of the airplane was approved in 1927 and was produced in some modifications. 1640 airplanes of given type were produced in total. DH-60 was used as a tourist and sports airplane and as an airplane for a long-distance flight.


