






ONE VERSION OF COLOURING

The Army KDA-2 Type 88 Reconnaissance. Aircraft was designed for Kawasaki in 1927. After Right testing, the aircraft was accepted and ordered into production as the Army Type 88-1 Reconnaissance Biplane. At the beginning of 1979 a new version of the aircraft the Type 88-II was designed and put into production. Between 1929 and 1932, a bomber version was built as the Type 88 Light Bomber, differred with a strengthened lower wing and an additional pair of centre-section struts. Both reconnaissance and bomber versions participated in combat of the Imperial Japanese Army Air Force during the Second Sino-Japanese War until 1940.

The model is executed on technology short run and is intended only for experienced modelers.
