






KDA-2 Type 88-II **Light Bomber**

The Army KDA-2 Type 88 Reconnaissance Aircraft was designed for Kawasaki in 1927. After hight testing, the aircraft was accepted and ordered into production as the Army Type 88-1 Reconnaissance Biplane. At the beginning of 1929 a new version of the aircraft the Type 88-II was designed and put into production. Between 1929 and 1932, a bomber version was built as tile Type 28 Light Bomber, differred with a strengthened lower wing and an additional pair of centre-section struts. Both reconnaissance and bomber versions participated in combat of the Imperial Japanese Army Air Force during the Second Sino-Japanese War until 1940.
