



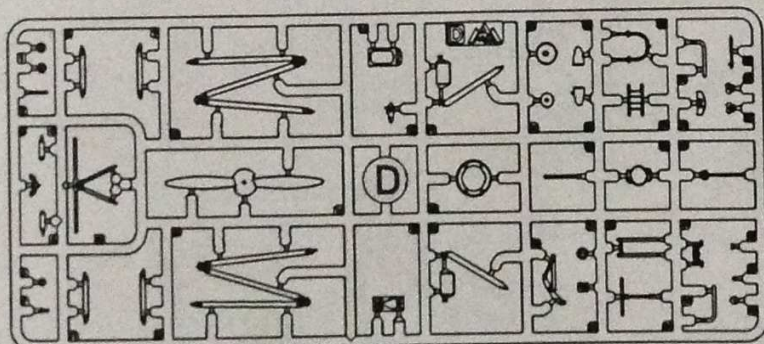
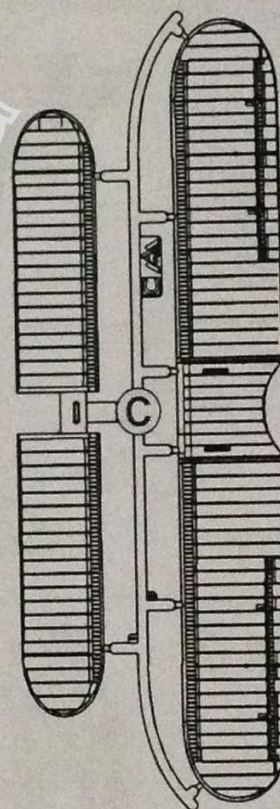
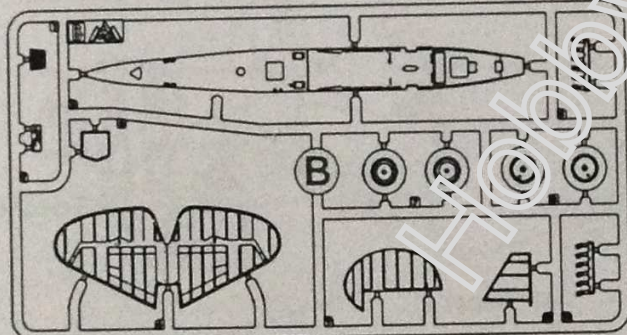
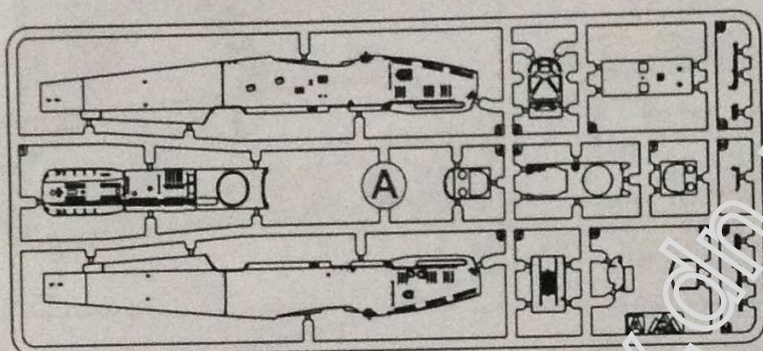
# Polikarpov R-5

The R-5 was a biplane reconnaissance and light bomber that was produced in vast numbers in the Soviet Union in the pre-war years.

The R-5 was designed while N. Polikarpov was working as the chief designer at Moscow's №25 factory. It was designed to be simple to fly, have a long life and be of wooden construction. It was designed around the BMW VI inline engine, which then entered licence production in the SU as the M-17.

The R-5 became the standard reconnaissance, bomber and attack aircraft with the SU AF, being used in large numbers, with over 100 air regiments equipped with the R-5. This aircraft took active part in the Nomonhan Incident, Soviet invasion of Poland and Winter War against Finland. They remained in service during the war against Germany in 1941-45, where they were mainly used as night bombers and liaison aircraft, serving until 1945!

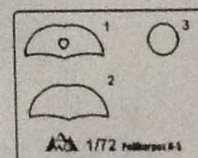
Eventually 7,000 aircraft were built over seven (1930-1936) years.

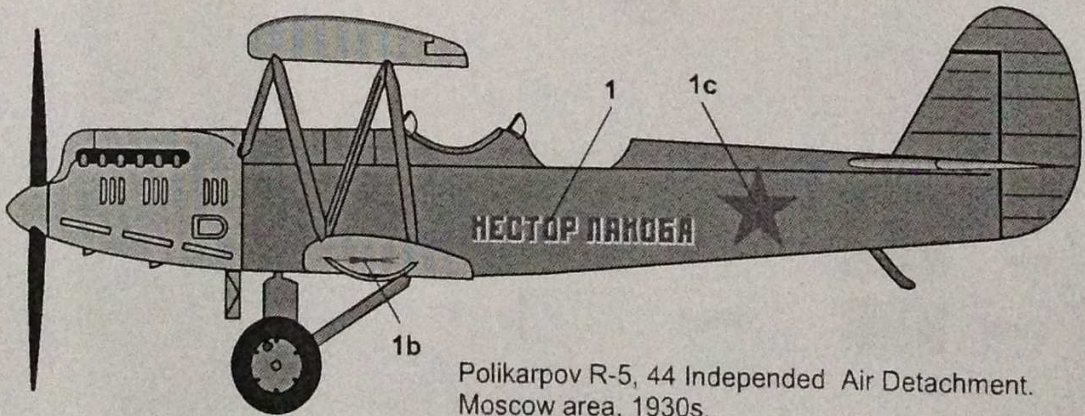
Polikarpov R-5, 37 L.Bombing Sqn, 454 Air brigade.

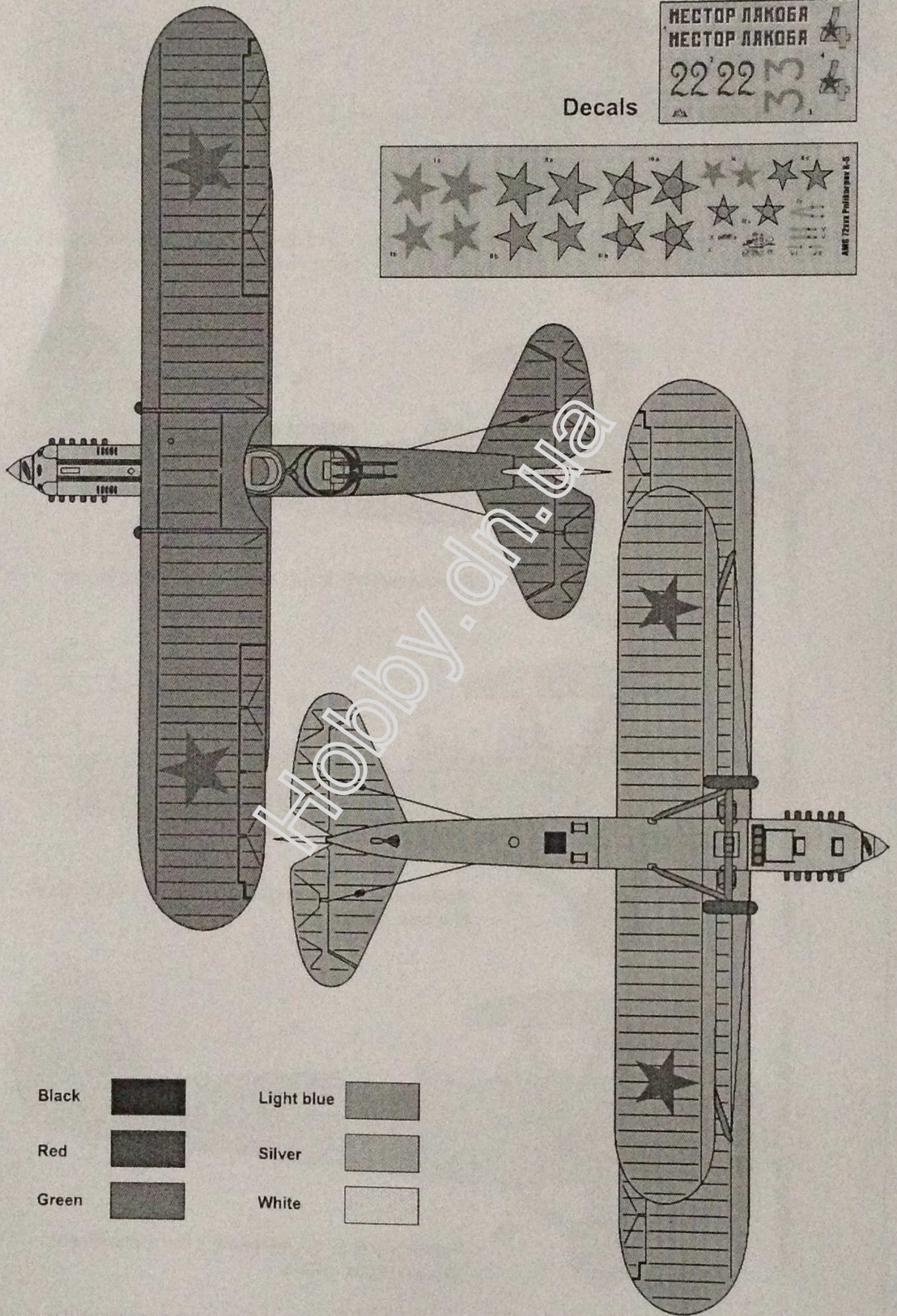
Polikarpov R-5, Soviet Union 1928, unit unknown

Moscow, 1930

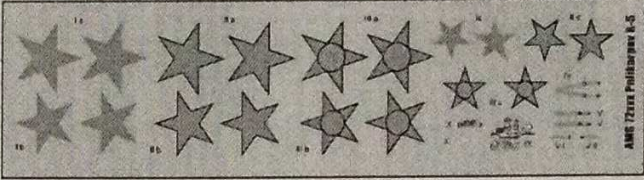








Polikarpov R-5, 44 Independent Air Detachment.
