





HFB-320/EMC Hansa Jet

The HFB-320 Hansa Jet is a twin-engine, teriseat business jet that was built by German aircraft manufacturer Hamburger Flugzeugbau between 1964 and 1973. The prototype first fiew on 21 April 1964 and was exhibited at the May 1964 Hanover Air Show. A second prototype was flown on 19 October 1964. The German Air Force had ordered 13 HFB 320s in 1963. As part of the evaluation of the type, two preproduction aircraft were delivered to the ErpSt 61 test wing at Oberpfaffenhoffen in 1966. This resulted in six aircraft being ordered for VIP use by the German Air Force. Production deliveries for use as VIP transports commenced in 1969.
