





ONE VERSION OF COLOURING

In 1930, General Aviation designed a 10 sean passenger aircraft, designated as ceneral Aviation G.A.43. The maiden flight of the prototype aircraft (NX775N) took place on 22nd of May, 1932. For the early 1930s, the aircraft had very advanced onboard equipment, which included a full set of flight instruments for "Non-visual" flight, radio and transmitting equipment, as well as a short-wave receiver for promptly receiving weather forecasts and radio beacon signals. Sadly, the plane did not reach commercial success - only five machines of that type were built.
